

**REGULAR MEETING OF THE LOCKEFORD

The Regular meeting of the Lockeford CSD was called to order at 9:00 A.M. by President Gary Gordon

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS:

A motion was made by Nina Chandler, seconded by Jane Loney, to accept the minutes of March 11, 2021. Motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Jacob Bridgewater introduced himself to the board as the new President for Friends of the Lockeford Memorial Park.

OLD BUSINESS:

SGMA: No new update.

Park Update: Tim Loney gave an update on the current state of the park. Two new benches and exercise stations have been ordered. Friends of Lockeford Memorial Park will also be funding the cleaning of 80 chairs at the center.

NEW BUSINESS:

Nina Chandler stated it is still recommended by the Health Department to wear a face covering, and would like to make it rule to wear one, when in the building. Jane Loney presented to the board that there is no statutory law that mandates masks and doing so could be considered discrimination which could lead to a lawsuit. Ozzie Neal recommended signs be put on the door that request face coverings be worn when in the building and the chairs be separated, to which everyone accepted.
